She is certified as a Diplomate of Oriental Medicine with the National Certification Commission for Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine (NCCAOM), which includes certification in Acupuncture, Chinese Herbology, and Clean Needle Technique. She also maintains her Doctor of Oriental Medicine license in the state of New Mexico.

Margo's Oriental Medicine training includes adjunctive therapies such as Chinese herbal medicine, cupping, moxibustion, acupuncture, auriculotherapy, and dietary and lifestyle recommendations.
